2) The request letter received from the 12th plan faculty members has been discussed and it is resolved to take the issue to the authorities to make necessary arrangements to regularize them.

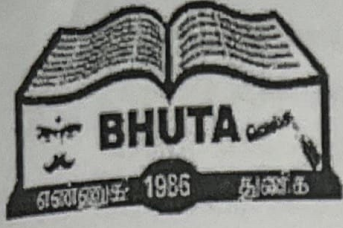
3) It is resolved to request the authorities to process the CAS application submitted by Dr. R. Sathishkumar, Dept. of Biotechnology if he is eligible.

The meeting of the executive committee was held on 10.12.2018 to discuss various issues concerning the University and members of BHUTA. The minutes of the meeting given under are submitted for your reference:

1. BHUTA strongly condemns the Vice-Chancellor Committee member Dr. P. Thirunavukkarasu, to dissent the decision of the syndicate. His action doesn't reflect the basic ethics and integrity expected from the member occupying the position at the helm of the university. BHUTA registers the strong condemnation and request the convener and syndicate members to remove Dr. P. Thirunavukkarasu from the Vice-Chancellors Committee immediately.

2. BHUTA requests the authorities of the University to take necessary steps to obtain required permissions from regulatory bodies and to run the Distance Education Programme following all legal and regulatory norms.

3. BHUTA thanks all the members for their timely and generous contribution to Gaja Cyclone relief. Moreover, we also sincerely thank BHUTA office bearers / members (Dr. A. Manimekalan, Dr. S. Girija, Dr. R. Annadurai, Dr. K. Vasanth, Dr. M. Gnanadesigan, Dr. G. Kapildev) for visiting the cyclone affected areas in person and distributing the relief materials worth more than Rupees Two lakhs to the affected people.
4. Dr. T. Parimelazhagan, Professor, Department of Botany submitted the request regarding his study leave abroad. It is resolved to recommend to the authorities to take necessary steps to offer leave salary to Dr. T. 5. It is resolved to hold the General Body meeting of BHUTA on 18th February 2019.


6. It is resolved to felicitate the non-teaching staff members retiring from the University service on 31st January 2019.
7. It is resolved to request the authorities to post the minutes of the Syndicate Meeting in the University web portal like other Universities (e.g. Periyar University, Salem).
8. It is resolved to request the University Administration to issue circular on inviting application from eligible faculties under CAS.
9. It is resolved to request the University authorities to release the list of faculty seniority at the earliest.
10. It is resolved to request the University authorities to consider the appointment of the University faculty to the syndicate and other administrative positions as per seniority.
11. It is resolved to request the University authorities to initiate immediate steps to fill the posts of Registrar, Director-School of Distance Education, Controller of Examinations and Dean-College Development Council at the earliest.
12. It is resolved to request the University authorities to immediately withdraw more than one additional charges held by a faculty and redistribute them. Further, while assigning additional charges to the faculty member's one man one post policy may be strictly adopted.
13. It is resolved to request the University authorities to maintain the specified cadres for the additional charges.
14. It is resolved to request the University authorities to consider the date of CAS promotion to the members of faculty who hold membership in the University Syndicate in the cadre of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor and are qualified for the positions of Associate Professor and Professor under CAS during the period of their membership in the syndicate shall be fixed as the date on or after they relinquish the membership in the syndicate or the date on which the term ends, but not retrospectively.
15. It is resolved to request the University authorities to consider the date of promotion to the members of faculty who hold membership in the University Syndicate in the cadre of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor and did not claim promotion under CAS, though they are qualified, for the purpose of continuing as members in the syndicate, shall be fixed as the date on or after they relinquish the membership in the syndicate or the date on which the term ends, but not retrospectively.
16. It is resolved to request the University authorities to consider the date of promotion to the members of faculty, who do/did not claim promotion under CAS, though they are

qualified, for the purpose of getting nomination as members in the syndicate as per seniority, shall be fixed as the date on or after they relinquish the membership (if nominated) in the syndicate or the date on which the term ends, but not retrospectively.

17. It is resolved to request the University authorities to establish a separate and strong legal wing by appointing appropriate counsels to expedite and complete all the cases and other legal issues pending in various courts.
18. It is resolved to request the University authorities to take necessary steps to declare probation to the newly recruited faculties.
19. It is resolved to request the University authorities to bring the CAS under IQAC as per the UGC regulations 2018.



The executive committee of BHUTA requests the authorities to urgently look into the following issues concerning the University and the members of BHUTA. These issues were previously represented on several occasions by BHUTA but no action on these was taken so far. These pending issues are as follows:

1. To immediately issue the pay fixation orders for the faculty members promoted from various cadres under CAS recently.
2. To release the non-compound increment arrear for the fixation orders issued during June 2, 2018.
3. To consider the appointment of the University faculty to the syndicate and other administrative positions as per seniority.
4. It is resolved to request the University authorities to immediately withdraw more than one addition charges held by a faculty and redistribute them. Further, while assigning additional charges to the faculty member's one man one post policy may be strictly adopted.
5. Headship rotation may be adopted with immediate effect as per the University act and statutes.
6. The University authorities may take necessary steps to declare probation to the newly recruited faculty members.

8. To revise the promotion date as on due irrespective of the refresher/orientation course UGC completion criteria.

10. To issue new circular on inviting application from eligible faculties under CAS.
11. To issue the pending CAS promotion orders for faculty members of Stage-I to Stage II.
12. To initiate immediate steps to fill the posts of Registrar, Director School of Distance Education, Controller of Examinations and Dean-College Development Council at the earliest.
13. The University authorities should maintain the specified cadres for the additional charges.
14. To establish a separate and strong legal wing by appointing appropriate counsels to expedite and complete all the cases and other legal issues pending in various courts.
15. To bring the CAS under IQAC and to conduct CAS every six months periodically as per the UGC regulations 2018.
16. To grant special permission for the enrollment of students working in funded projects irrespective of the UGC Ph.D., guidance limit for Assistant and Associate Professors.
17. To immediately implement the Institutional overhead charges for the sponsored projects sanctioned by the various funding agencies (RC Circular No. C7/12747/2016, dated 18.01.2017)
18. To take necessary steps to offer leave salary to Dr. T. Ponnambalam Department of Botany as per the UGC guidelines for grant of study leave
19. To post the minutes of the HOD's meeting in the intranet.

20. To strengthen the University security system to curtail the various unwanted activities in the University campus.
21. To discuss and solve the issues in the allotment of staff quarters with the concerned parties.
22. To take necessary action to divert the ring road bypassing the University campus.


